The company showed off a new, fake, logo as part of the stunt.

Volkswagen has apologised for "any confusion" as it admitted that an electric car PR stunt on Tuesday 30 March was an attempt at an April Fool's joke.

News outlets globally, including Sky News, faithfully reported then how the company's US operation planned to change its name to 'Voltswagen of America' from May.

It has spent several years trying to restore its reputation in the country through a green future in the wake of the dieselgate scandal.

VW's cheating of world emissions-testing regimes cost it more than \$30bn (£21.7bn) in the US alone and it has since placed itself at the forefront of the global shift from conventionally-powered vehicles to all-electric.

Volkswagen started deliveries of the new allelectric SUV the ID.4 earlier this month. Volkswagen was trying to draw attention to the new ID.4 SUV. Pic: AP But the company admitted late on Tuesday night, US time, that the name change was an April Fool's joke and PR stunt to draw attention to the launch of its new SUV.

There has previously been frustration expressed by VW officials that its electric vehicle efforts have attracted less media and public attention than Tesla.

A spokesperson for VW later told the Reuters news agency it had intended to raise the profile of the new car in a "fun and interesting way".

"At the same time, we realise the announcement rollout upset some people and we are sorry about any confusion this has caused."

The world's second-largest carmaker expects to double electric vehicle deliveries and boost profits for its core brand this year after stepping up its switch to fully electric vehicles.

Orbiting spacecraft are usually higher to avoid atmospheric drag. The Apollo moon missions used to orbit at 180 km before moving on. Skylab was parked at 450 km in 1974 and it fell back and burned up in 1979. The ISS is usually about the same height, but it is regularly lifted with rocket boosters to compensate for drag. The Hubble Telescope is around 550 km up, which was as high as the space shuttle could reach.

Satellites can be anything from hundreds to tens of thousands of km up. Geosynchronous satellites, which orbit at the same rate the Earth spins so they remain fixed above one ground location, are 35,780 km up. It would take your car over a fortnight to drive up that high at 100 km/h, 24/7.

To get to the Moon would take a considerably longer though, since it's 400,000 kilometres away – around ten times the circumference of the earth. So it would take as long as driving

around the world ten times- just under six months, non-stop.

Your only problem (apart from the lack of air for your lungs and for burning the petrol) would be finding a garage to refuel - and that has a loo!

So for me it's always a big deal when my work Volkswagen can make it to out to 400,000 kilometres.

Over the years I've driven a few Volkswagens to the Moon but they have normally needed the engine head replaced twice to get there.

This is the first Volkswagen I've ever had that ever made it to 400,000 without ever needing anything major, only the normal things that don't last forever.

In business, if you can get this from your work vehicle, it means you're making money and getting the job done.

It's getting a bit furry now and may need replacing soon but it still loves going to work every day.

It just goes to show how good Volkswagens are for work these days.

In the old days it was cheaper to drive a Ford, Holden or Toyota for work, but not anymore.

They were the boring old days.

These days you can easily have Volkswagen for work and not worry.

Of course everyone knows my favourite is the 1.6 petrol manual Caddy van. Why not drive one to the Moon, or ten times around the world.

The ones that got away

Most vintage car enthusiasts can tell you stories of the one that got away. The number of Ovals and split screen Kombis that I have



knocked back over the years make me wish for a time machine. In the early 70s I had 1963 austerity model Beetle that I thought was great, why would I want an old fashioned Oval. I was even offered a Karmann Ghia that had an engine fire very cheaply with all the bits to fix it, I thought the back seat wasn't roomy enough to carry my mates around in.

I used to work for a division of Provincial Motors a VW dealer in Liverpool, it was called Automotive Imports and sold VW parts made by mostly factory suppliers to dealers and private VW workshops which in 1970s were dotted all over suburban Sydney and lots of them were in backyard garages.

For a while I was a sales rep with them and travelled all over Sydney selling parts to these suburban VW workshops. One service station workshop that I particularly remember was in President Ave Sutherland in the lube bay was the holy grail of vintage VWs, a split window Beetle. I pestered the guy to sell it to me but to no avail. I left the sales rep job and started working in VW dealers in the VW parts department. One day I thought I should go and check on the Split Screen Beetle at Sutherland, to my horror the service station was still there but was now a fruit market.

In the late eighties I bought a 54/55 Oval with plans to restore it, it was pretty solid car but was painted that later VW Beetle colour Honey Brown. Sadly we then moved from a house with a four car garage to one with a very small two car garage so in 1992 I had to sell the Oval as I had nowhere to store it.

Fast forward to 1997 when the club had a run up to Mount Victoria where Phil Mass was screening the movie that he had put together featuring the VW Nationals from earlier that year.


A lovely couple who were club members turned up as we got to talking his wife encouraged him to tell us about the cars that he had collected, he had few Ovals and English cars and old Mercs but then said I have a split window Beetle, I nearly fell of my chair. The next day he arranged for the club to visit his home in Hartley just down the hill from Mount Victoria.

The club members name was Don Carter, no relation and he was policeman in the Shire and Illawarra in the 1970,s you guessed it, the split windscreen Beetle he had was the very same one that I lusted after in Sutherland all those years ago. Don told me that he knew the proprietor of the servo in Sutherland and that he was working at local club, Don arranged to purchase the split screen Beetle from him and I can still remember Don telling me that he bought it on the 7/7/1977, by this time I had told Don of my tenuous link to this car.

More years passed and Don and I kept in contact and when his health started t fail he put his car collection up for sale and offered me the split screen Beetle, I sadly had to decline as I had nowhere to store the car plus my wife would have killed me as I was doing a ground up build on my Orange L Bug/1303.

I often drive along Stoney Creek Road at Bexley and always saw a Beetle up a driveway and under a tarp, one day the tarp was off I and I saw that it was a 1956 Oval, on my way home from Boris' Picnic day in 2018 I stopped outside the house at Bexley and the owner of the Oval was standing in his front yard, I said what are you doing with Beetle, he replied I don't know so I offered to buy it, a few days later he called me and I bought the oval from













him at what I thought was a reasonable price but have since found it was a bit of a bargain.

The Oval was an ex South Australian car so had no rust and was half stripped with some attempts at restoring it, it was in very thick primer which would need to be stripped, had a 4 stud disc brake conversion, lowered front beam, later 1500 transmission with short Oval axles and upright converted 1500 Type 3 motor with a Holley Bugspray. So it's now had a bare metal respray in a 1958 VW Capri Blue, much nicer than Manley tan that it originally came out in. I'm still putting it back together, and I'm keeping this one and no I'm not fitting a Subaru motor!

I often wonder what modern VW cars will become collectable in the future just like Beetles, Kombis and early Golfs have become.
